

Guidelines for State Tournament Spectators

(as taken from NSAA manual and correspondence)

Students and team followers are expected to exhibit sportsmanlike behavior during the tournament. Any person becoming disorderly will be removed from the game site.

Signs and Banners

Handheld signs, which are not directed at the opposition and are not derogatory in nature, may be held in the seating areas. Signs should not be carried around the floor. **Due to facility restrictions – BANNERS will not be allowed to be hung in Pinnacle Bank Arena or Devaney**

Signs, banners, flags should not be carried around the floor.

Artificial Noisemakers

The use of artificial noisemakers is prohibited. (included but not limited to airhorns, cow bells, bells, buzzers, clickers, thunder sticks, rattles, instruments not part of a band.), whistles, air horns/sirens

Megaphones are to be used by cheerleaders only. Band instruments, including drums, are not to be played at any time other than when the entire band is playing. Bands should not be permitted to play except prior to the game, at intermissions and time-outs.

Misc. Information

Spectators are required to wear shirts

Balloons will not be allowed in the facilities

Items by team members or fans shall not be thrown into the crowd

Confetti/shredded paper, powder, laser light/pointer/flashing objects are not acceptable

INFORMATION SPECIFIC TO LINCOLN EAST HIGH SCHOOL

- The main ticket entrance will be on the south side of East High School (Door 21). General parking is the Seacrest Field parking lot located south and east of the gym doors. This is our student lot, but school will be dismissed at 11:30 that day, so parking should be plentiful.

The easiest access to this lot is to enter off of A Street, approximately 3 blocks east of 70th, and then drive back north toward the school.

- At the end of each game, it is expected that teams will leave the court and go into the locker room in order to prepare the floor for the next game. Players will not be allowed to return to the court after the game, but there will be a place for players to meet parents and fans following each game. Team hosts will direct them to that area. In order to accommodate the next team using the locker room, the team should finish using the locker room PRIOR to going upstairs to meet friends and family.
