

Bertrand Community School – Winter Activity Guidelines (Updated Jan. 4, 2021)

Bertrand Community School will have the following procedures in place for activities held at our facilities that pertain to our NSAA activities involving our student-athletes. (These procedures are subject to change in response to COVID-19 updates)

The NSAA is requiring the following of host schools for all winter season contests:

- Participants are permitted, but not required, to wear face coverings during competition.
- Coaches and non-active participants are required to wear face coverings at all times.
- Spectators are required to wear face coverings at all times while attending indoor events.
- Host school requirements must be the same for all schools, officials, judges and spectators.

All participating schools, officials, judges and spectators are expected to adhere to these requirements.

Boys/Girls Basketball:

- Anyone entering the facility must do so with a mask on; the mask is required to stay on during the time the guest is in the facility; considerations will be given to times in which food is consumed, but this is asked to be timely.
- Guest fans will enter through the east, main entry doors off the parking lot, and will occupy the east bleachers.
- Home fans will enter through the north doors by the concession stand, and will occupy the west bleachers.
- All spectators will be temperature checked at the entry.
- Locker rooms will be assigned per normal, w/ each boy and girl team being able to have their own locker room facility.
- We are going to have a concession stand; workers will wear masks and gloves to serve. Anyone wishing to purchase something from the concession stand will need to wear a mask. There will be dividers at the concession stand. We ask that fans observe/stay on their respective sides of the barriers.
- Restroom facilities will be available for all fans to use.
- Disinfectant wipes and hand sanitizer will be available for all spectators to use during events.
- The current NSAA protocol calls for school extra-curricular activities will be limited to 50% capacity; no restrictions on who can attend.
 - We will use a guest/pass list for Bertrand athletes' families for their guaranteed admittance.
 - Number of available seats on the home side of bleachers beyond the Bertrand athlete pass lists will be publicized prior to the event and will be First Come, First Serve.
- All family members will still be expected/required to sit together as a group.
- Cheerleaders (home or guest) will be allowed, and will be located in specific areas.

*** At the conclusion of the contest, spectators will not be allowed to gather on the court/field/track. Teams will be expected to vacate the playing area very shortly after the end of the contest. (Home athletes will be required to exit the building as soon as they are done in the locker room).**
